

History of the Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Fund

The Czech Heritage Foundation understands the importance and high cost of education for youth. It has therefore established the Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Fund for applicants of Czech/Slovak ancestry. The program was established in 1985 and, as of 2007, has given 51 scholarships to worthy applicants. Generally, winners receive a \$500 scholarship, but in 2006 and 2007 that amount was raised to \$750. The amount and number of scholarships to be given annually is at the discretion of the Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Board and is voted on once a year.

The Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Fund has monies available for applicants of Czech ancestry who have completed a minimum of one year as a full time post secondary student, have accumulated at least 28 post secondary credits, or are a graduate student. (Note: the scholarship may be awarded up to two times to the same individual, once as an undergraduate and once as a graduate student.)

The amount(s) and number of scholarships will be determined by the Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Board. The applicant(s) selected to receive a scholarship will be notified of the award and the amount. Funds will be sent at the proper time directly to the recipient(s).

Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Fund

1. ***Purpose:*** The purpose of this scholarship fund is to provide financial assistance to students of Czech/Slovak heritage who are attending an accredited post-secondary education institution on a full time basis.
2. ***Applicant Requirements:***
 - a. The applicant must have Czech/Slovak ancestry
 - b. The applicant must have completed a minimum of one year as a full time post secondary student or accumulated at least 28 post secondary credits.
 - c. The applicant must be enrolled full time in an accredited post secondary education institution.
 - d. Every applicant must complete an application form. The application must be postmarked on or before July 1st of the application year and mailed to:

3. ***Evaluation Criteria:***
 - a. 25% - Academic achievement
 - b. 25% - Need
 - c. 25% - Support of Czech/Slovak Heritage
 - d. 25% - Character and school activities
4. ***Fund Administration by the Scholarship Board:***
 - a. The Scholarship Board is composed of members who are appointed by the President of the Czech Heritage Foundation, with approval of the Czech Heritage Foundation. The officers of the Scholarship Board shall include a secretary and treasurer, selected by the scholarship board.
 - b. The Scholarship Board will have the authority to determine who shall receive awards. The scholarship may be awarded up to two times to the same individual, once as an undergraduate and once as a graduate student.
 - c. The amounts(s) and number of scholarships will be determined by the Scholarship Board. Only interest received from invested funds may be used to establish the amount available for scholarships. This will be a determining factor as to the number of awards and the amount of each award.
 - d. The applicants(s) selected to receive a scholarship will be notified of the award and the amount. The funds will be sent at the proper time directly to the recipient(s).
 - e. A financial report of the Scholarship Fund and an annual audit will be made at each annual meeting of the Czech Heritage Foundation.
5. ***Recipient Default:*** If a scholarship recipient fails to attend the accredited educational institution listed on the application form or drops out of school during the year, the scholarship funds MUST be returned to the Czech Heritage Foundation Scholarship Board.

Scholarship winners are asked to support the Czech Heritage Foundation in one or more of the following ways:

- Attend a function sponsored by the Czech Heritage Foundation, such as the St. Joseph's Day Dance held in March or the Czech Heritage Foundation Picnic in August.
- Donate a door prize for the St. Joseph's Day Dance
- Participate in the Houby Days festival held in May by working at the information booth or selling Czech Heritage Foundation merchandise.
